**CHAPTER 371**

AN ACT to amend 100.30 (2) (i) of the statutes, relating to the unfair sales act.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

100.30 (2) (i) of the statutes is amended to read:

100.30 (2) (i) The term "retailer" and the term "wholesaler" shall both be applied to all merchants buying \* \* \* *from the manufacturer any* merchandise to be sold at retail by such merchants, and both the wholesale markup of 2 per cent to cover in part the cost of doing business, and the retail markup of 6 per cent to cover in part the cost of doing business, shall be added to the invoice cost on all *such* merchandise \* \* \* *so purchased from the manufacturer.*
