CHAPTER 386

AN ACT to renumber 221.14 (4); and to create 221.14 (4) (b) of the statutes, relating to paying and receiving windows on banking parking lots.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 221.14 (4) of the statutes is renumbered 221.14 (4) (a).

SECTION 2. 221.14 (4) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

221.14 (4) (b) In addition to the exclusive use for parking, there may be established and maintained on such real estate, if contiguous to the land on which the bank is located, paying and receiving windows. Such windows may be established without specific approval by the commissioner. In determining whether or not such real estate is contiguous to the land on which the bank is located, an intervening public alley shall not be considered to render it noncontiguous.
