

CHAPTER 494

AN ACT to create 59.07 (67) of the statutes, relating to authorizing county boards to call for advisory referendums at any general, primary or municipal election.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.07 (67) of the statutes is created to read:

59.07 (67) By a three-fourths vote of the members elect, authorize a referendum to be voted on by the electors of the county at any general, primary or municipal election held in said county and to appropriate money to defray the expense of the same on public construction questions, concerning which the board desires to be advised by the electors of the county. Such referendums shall be conducted only in respect to matters properly coming within the jurisdiction of the board, and the effect thereof shall be advisory only.
