CHAPTER 500

AN ACT to create chapter 646, laws of 1951, section 3, relating to empowering the city of Menasha to convey certain lands lying along the shores of Little Lake Butte des Morts, on the west frontage of said city, to the adjoining property owners to preserve their riparian rights.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 646, laws of 1951, section 3 is created to read:

(Chapter 646, laws of 1951) SECTION 3. The city of Menasha is authorized and directed to quit claim its right, title and interest to the lands described in section 1 to the adjoining property owners who have riparian rights, reserving to such city the right to enact ordinances permitting fishing from the shores of such lake and providing that the rights of such riparian owner grantees be subordinate to the right of the state to aid navigation upon said Little Lake Butte des Morts.
