CHAPTER 577

AN ACT to create 947.045 of the statutes, relating to prohibiting drinking or opening containers of fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquor in moving motor vehicles on public highways and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

947.045 of the statutes is created to read:

947.045 DRINKING IN MOTOR VEHICLES ON HIGHWAYS.
Whoever drinks from or opens a container of fermented malt beverage or intoxicating liquor in a moving motor vehicle on a public highway may be fined not more than \$100. This section does not apply to a motor bus as defined in s. 340.01 (31).
