CHAPTER 611

AN ACT to amend 49.40 (2) of the statutes, relating to reimbursement to the counties for medical care.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

49.40 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

49.40 (2) Upon forms prescribed by the department claims by counties for reimbursement shall be made at the same time and in the same manner as other claims for aid to the blind, aid to dependent children, old-age assistance and aid to the totally and permanently disabled and if approved by the department 35 per cent of such expenditures * * *

after deduction of any federal aid that may be received for such expenditures shall be certified by the department to the director of budget and accounts as reimbursement to the counties. Any federal aid that may be received for such expenditures shall be certified by the department to the director of budget and accounts as reimbursement to the counties. To facilitate prompt reimbursement the certification of the department may be based upon the certified statements of the county officers, provided that any necessary audit adjustments for any month of current or prior years may be included in subsequent certifications.
