CHAPTER 686

AN ACT to create 20.005 (2) (a) (lines 338f and 338g) of the statutes, to appropriate \$5,000 from the highway fund to Richard J. Johnson, Julius C. Johnson, Harold L. Utne and Ralph E. Utne for payment of damages resulting from activities of the state highway commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (2) (a) (lines 338f and 338g) of the statutes are created to read:

20.005 (2) (a)

338f. Richard J. Johnson and Julius C. Johnson	\$2,500
338g. Harold L. Utne and Ralph E. Utne	2,500

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the state highway fund \$2,500 to Richard J. Johnson and Julius C. Johnson and \$2,500 to Harold L. Utne and Ralph E. Utne in payment of their claims against the state because of the flooding of their farms near Blair, Wisconsin, in 1953, which was caused in part by the reconstruction of highway 53. Acceptance of these appropriations shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.
