CHAPTER 692

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 42.49 (10) (d), as created by chapter 376, laws of 1957; and to create 42.49 (10) (ab) of the statutes, relating to adjusted benefits under the state teachers retirement system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 42.49 (10) (ab) of the statutes is created to read:

42.49 (10) (ab) For the purposes of par. (a), a year of teaching experience includes a year for which a retired teacher was given retirement credit under the statutes of 1911 to 1919 inclusive, relating to the teachers' insurance and retirement fund.

SECTION 2. 42.49 (10) (d) of the statutes, as created by chapter 376, laws of 1957, is repealed and recreated to read:

42.49 (10) (d) If a teacher has received his earliest insured status under the federal old-age and survivors insurance system solely as a result of having been a participant in the substitute teachers roster under s. 39.35, the benefits received under par. (a) or (b) for any month shall be reduced by an amount equal to any benefits received on account of his insured status under the federal old-age and survivors insurance system for said month, but such reduction shall not exceed \$30 per month. Each such teacher may be required, as a condition of receiving benefits under this subsection, to authorize the social security administration to provide the state teachers retirement system with information regarding the benefits payable to such teacher from the federal old-age and survivors insurance system.
