CHAPTER 87

AN ACT to repeal chapter 207, private and local laws of 1867, as amended by chapters 350 and 477, private and local laws of 1868; chapters 301 and 469, private and local laws of 1871; chapter 16, laws of 1883; chapter 101, laws of 1893; chapter 178, laws of 1901; and chapter 200, laws of 1905; and to create and establish a common school district in the city of Brodhead and certain additional territory in Green and Rock counties, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 207, private and local laws of 1867, authorizing a common school district in the village (now city) of Brodhead and parts of the towns of Decatur and Spring Grove in Green county and Spring Valley in Rock county, as amended by chapters 350 and 477, private and local laws of 1868; chapters 301 and 469, private and local laws of 1871; chapter 16, laws of 1883; chapter 101, laws of 1893; chapter 178, laws of 1901; and chapter 200, laws of 1905, is repealed. All orders issued pursuant to general law affecting the district thus created are rescinded.

SECTION 2. The territory included in joint district no. 1, Brodhead, by chapter 207, private and local laws of 1867, as amended by chapters

350 and 477, private and local laws of 1868; chapters 301 and 469, private and local laws of 1871; chapter 16, laws of 1883; chapter 101, laws of 1893; chapter 178, laws of 1901; and chapter 200, laws of 1905, and all orders issued in accordance with chapter 40, of the statutes, is hereby constituted joint district no. 1, city of Brodhead, towns of Decatur, Spring Grove and Spring Valley, which shall derive its corporate powers from the general laws of the state of Wisconsin, shall be subject to all provisions of chapter 40, of the statutes, now in force or as hereafter created or amended and shall possess all of the rights, powers and privileges of such districts in this state and only such rights, powers and privileges.

SECTION 3. All the assets and liabilities of joint district no. 1, Brodhead as constituted on the date on which this act takes effect, and as constituted by chapter 207, private and local laws of 1867, as amended, are hereby made the assets and liabilities of joint school district no. 1, city of Brodhead, towns of Decatur, Spring Grove and Spring Valley, as created under general law by this act.

SECTION 4. At the first regular annual meeting in July, 1957, held by joint district no. 1, city of Brodhead, towns of Decatur, Spring Grove and Spring Valley, after the enactment of this chapter, the district shall organize in accordance with general law. At such meeting the electors shall determine whether the district shall have 3, 5, 7 or 9 members on the board as provided in chapter 40, of the statutes. All subsequent changes in the organization shall be made in accordance with general law. The clerk of the existing district shall give notice of the time and place of such meeting. The existing board shall continue until the new board has been selected and qualified.
