CHAPTER 355

AN ACT to create 39.02 (25) of the statutes, relating to high school graduation equivalency.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

39.02 (25) of the statutes is created to read:

39.02 (25) TO DECLARE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION EQUIVALENCY. The state superintendent of public instruction may grant persons declarations of equivalency of high school graduation if in his judgment they have presented satisfactory evidence of having completed a recognized high school course of study or its equivalent. He may establish the standards by which high school graduation equivalency may be determined. Such standards may consist of evidence of high school courses completed in high schools recognized by the proper authorities as accredited, results of examinations given by or at the request of the state superintendent, successful completion of correspondence study courses given by acceptable correspondence study schools, course credits received in schools meeting the approval of the state superintendent or by other standards established by him.
