**CHAPTER 691**

AN ACT to amend 251.04 (6) of the statutes, relating to permitting a supreme court justice to employ a law examiner.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 251.04 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

251.04 (6) \* \* \* *Each justice* may employ \* \* \* *one attorney* at law to assist \* \* \* *him* as law \* \* \* *examiner* and to perform such other duties as \* \* \* *he* may require. Each such attorney shall be admitted to practice as an attorney in all courts of this state \* \* \*. The salary of each such attorney shall not exceed \* \* \* \$6,000 per annum.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1961.
