**CHAPTER 365**

AN ACT to amend 46.064 of the statutes, relating to allowances to inmates.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

46.064 of the statutes is amended to read:

46.064 The department may allow as pay to inmates at its institutions not to exceed 10 cents per day and not to exceed 50 cents per calendar week for employment to be paid from the appropriation made by s. 20.670 (31). The department shall prescribe the amount of pay and such reasonable hours, health and other conditions as shall be observed in connection with the employment. \* \* \* This section shall not affect any other statutory provision providing for pay to inmates nor shall these provisions act as a limitation on wages paid inmates at the \* \* \* state \* \* \* *prisons or to juveniles transferred to a forestry or conservation camp organized under s. 48.52 (1) (d).*
