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AN ACT to repeal 13.45 (3) (b); to amend 13.45 (2) and (3) (i); and to create 20.615 of the statutes, reorganizing the committee on physical plant maintenance to make it a permanent legislative committee and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 13.45 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

13.45 (2) The joint legislative committee on physical plant maintenance is created * * * consisting of one senator and 2 assemblymen who possess substantial experience in construction and related fields, appointed as are standing committees in the respective houses. * * * *The terms of all members shall expire the second Wednesday in January in each odd-numbered year.* The committee shall elect a chairman and secretary from among its membership. The members shall be reimbursed for their necessary expenses as provided in s. 20.530 (1) (c). *The committee shall be attached to the legislative council for purposes of fiscal accounting only.*

SECTION 2. 13.45 (3) (b) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 13.45 (3) (i) of the statutes is amended to read:

13.45 (3) (i) Report its findings, conclusions and recommendations to the * * * legislature by February 1 of each odd-numbered year.

SECTION 4. 20.615 of the statutes is created to read:

20.615 PHYSICAL PLANT MAINTENANCE COMMITTEE. (1) On July 1, 1961, and biennially thereafter, there is appropriated to the physical plant maintenance committee \$1,500 to carry out the provisions of s. 13.45.
