CHAPTER 104

AN ACT to renumber 409.407; and to create 409.407 (2) and (3) of the statutes, relating to the duties of filing officers under the uniform commercial code.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 409.407 of the statutes is renumbered 409.407 (1).

SECTION 2. 409.407 (2) and (3) of the statutes are created to read:

409.407 (2) **ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE; FEES.** Upon request of any person, the filing officer shall issue his certificate showing whether there is on file on the date and hour stated therein, any untermiated financing statement filed or continued within the preceding 6 years naming a particular debtor and any statement of assignment thereof and if there is, giving the date and hour of filing of each such statement and the names and addresses of each secured party therein. The uniform fee for such a certificate is \$2, plus 50 cents for each financing statement and for each statement of assignment reported therein. Upon request the filing officer shall furnish a certified copy of any filed financing statement or statement of assignment for a uniform fee of \$1 for each page of the copied statement plus 50 cents for the certificate.

(3) **LIABILITY OF FILING OFFICER.** No filing officer nor any of his employes or agents shall be subject to personal liability by reason of any error or omission in the performance of any duty under ch. 409 except in case of misconduct as defined in s. 946.12.
