CHAPTER 205

AN ACT to create 59.514 of the statutes, relating to including the tax key number in any written instrument transferring title to real estate in populous counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.514 of the statutes is created to read:

59.514 INCLUDING TAX KEY NUMBER. In counties having a population of 500,000 or more where tax key numbers are used for ad valorem tax roll purposes in cities, villages or towns, any instrument conveying any interest in real estate located in such municipality shall contain reference to the key number affected. Such reference to the key number shall be for informational purposes only and shall not be a requirement for the recording of the instrument. This section shall not apply to any instrument conveying an easement right only.
