CHAPTER 316

AN ACT authorizing and directing the state department of public welfare, with approval of the governor, to convey to the town of Allouez certain state owned lands in the town of Allouez, Brown county, Wisconsin, therein described, to said town of Allouez for street or highway purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The state department of public welfare, with approval of the governor, is authorized and directed to convey, for street and highway purposes to the town of Allouez, a municipal corporation in Brown county, Wisconsin, the following described 2 parcels of land.

1. A strip of land 10 feet in width for highway purposes, being part of private claim 20, east side of Fox river, town of Allouez, Brown county, Wisconsin, extending 10 feet westerly from and adjacent to

the westerly property line of Libal street as presently defined, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeasterly corner of Rolling Acres plat, town of Allouez, Brown county, Wisconsin; thence 1169.82 feet S 26°-20'-20" W along the westerly property line of Libal street to the south line of said private claim 20; thence 10.00 feet N 64°-11'-00" W along the south line of said private claim 20; thence 1169.87 feet N 26°-20'-20" E to the southerly boundary line of said Rolling Acres plat; thence 10.00 feet S 63°-53'-20" E along the southerly boundary line of said Rolling Acres plat to the point of beginning.

2. The southerly 35 feet of that part of private claim 20, east side of Fox river, lying between Waubenoor drive and Webster street.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency bill, recommended by the joint committee on finance, in accordance with the requirements of section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
