CHAPTER 357

AN ACT to create 346.46 (4) of the statutes, requiring stops for official stop signs erected mid-block or at school crossings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

346.46 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

346.46 (4) (a) Every operator of a vehicle approaching an official stop sign or official temporary stop sign erected mid-block on or in the roadway by local authorities under s. 349.08 (5) shall cause such vehicle to stop not less than 10 nor more than 30 feet from such official sign except when directed to proceed by a traffic officer.

(b) As used in this subsection "mid-block" has the meaning given it in s. 346.33 (3).
