CHAPTER 391

AN ACT to amend 48.24 of the statutes, relating to court-ordered examinations of persons coming within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

48.24 of the statutes is amended to read:

48.24 *Upon a finding by the court that reasonable cause exists to warrant such examination*, the court may order any person coming within its jurisdiction to be examined by a clinical psychologist, having the qualifications required by s. 51.23, a psychiatrist or a physician, appointed by the court, in order that the condition of such person may be given due consideration in the disposition of the case. The expenses of such examination, when approved by the court, shall be paid by the county. In counties maintaining an examination service by one or more physicians, psychiatrists or clinical psychologists such county service shall be used for the purposes of this examination.
