CHAPTER 92

AN ACT to create 66.022 (4) of the statutes, to provide for temporary zoning in detachment proceedings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.022 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

66.022 (4) Whenever any area which has been subject to a city or village zoning ordinance is detached from one municipality and attached to another in accordance with this section, the regulations imposed by such zoning ordinance shall continue in effect and shall be enforced by the attaching city, village or town until changed by official action of the governing body of such municipality, except that if the detachment or attachment is contested in the courts, the zoning ordinance of the detaching municipality shall prevail, and such city or village shall have jurisdiction over the zoning in the area affected until ultimate determination of the court action.
