CHAPTER 97, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to renumber 145.06 (1); and to create 145.06 (1) (b) and (4) (f) of the statutes, relating to the exclusion of public utilities from engaging in plumbing and creating an exemption from licensure requirements for utilities having so engaged in plumbing for a period of time.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 145.06 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 145.06 (1) (a).

SECTION 2. 145.06 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

145.06 (1) (b) No public utility shall engage in or perform plumbing unless exempted by sub. (4).

SECTION 3. 145.06 (4) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

145.06 (4) (f) Installation, repair or replacement of water service piping, from the property line to the meter, including meter installation, to service any building or structure or proposed building or structure when such installation, repair or replacement is accomplished by employees of a public municipal water utility, providing such utility regularly has engaged in such installation, repair or replacement for at least 5 years prior to January 1, 1964.
