The general rule on members of a professional or occupational group serving on an administrative agency regulating such profession or occupation, applied in disciplinary cases involving licensees, is that membership in or connection with the same profession or occupation as that of the accused licensee does not alone indicate a disqualifying bias or interest on the part of the questioned tribunal

member sufficient to violate due process. *Kachian v. Optometry Ex. Board*, 44 W (2d) 1, 170 NW (2d) 743.

It does not follow, from the absence in ch. 153 of a specific provision for the disqualification of a board member where direct conflict of interest or actual bias can be proved to exist, that a person who is a member of an administrative agency may not or ought not disqualify himself from sitting in a case in which he has a direct financial interest or one which he cannot fairly decide, for the common-law duty of disqualification applies where no statutory provisions for disqualification are spelled out. *Kachian v. Optometry Ex. Board*, 44 W (2d) 1, 170 NW (2d) 743.

The real estate brokers' board can issue a subpoena duces tecum to require production of described papers and documents in an investigation where the board has proceeded under 136.08 (1), but not in an informal preliminary investigation. 47 Atty. Gen. 47.

Under 169.02, Stats. 1949, the state athletic commission has power to promulgate a rule regulating announcements of boxing cards. Power to revoke licenses to conduct boxing cards is in the commission and not in the secretary. 39 Atty. Gen. 312.

The real estate brokers' board does not have authority, under ch. 136, Stats. 1939, to require periodic reports relative to business engaged in by brokers. 20 Atty. Gen. 92.
