CHAPTER 268, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to create 66.057 (2) (f) of the statutes, relating to permitting the destruction of identification card applications.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.057 (2) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

66.057 (2) (f) *Length of time files retained.* The issuing officer may destroy identification card applications after they have been on file for 5 years.
