This is to inform you that on June 8, 1977, the Joint Committee on Employment Relations met and held a public hearing as to the tentative labor agreement arrived at between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Building Trades Negotiating Committee, for employes assigned to the Building Trades Crafts bargaining unit, after which the Committee approved such agreements and terms thereof.

In accordance with Section 111.92, Wisconsin Statutes, we are hereby introducing proposed legislation to approve and implement such agreements.

The Committee has concurred with the matters under consideration and recommends passage of the enclosed session law LRB-6342 without change.
