### SUSPENSION ORDER

Whereas, on July 30, 1980 the file in the Office of the Secretary of State of Wisconsin included among others the names of the following parties registered under s.13.64, Wis. Stats. as principals under the Wisconsin lobby law:

Wisconsin Federation of Teachers  
Milwaukee District Council 48, AFSCME  
The Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc.

Whereas, s.13.68 Wis. Stats. required each of said principals to file an expense statement with the Secretary of State on or before July 30, 1980, and whereas each of said principals failed to file such statement by said date; and

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Whereas, on August 8, 1980, under s.13.63(2), Wis. Stats. the Secretary of State mailed to each of said principals, and to each person registered as a lobbyist for each of said principals, a notice advising of such principal's failure to make such required expense statement filing and further advising that unless such statement was filed with the Secretary of State on or before August 18, 1980, the privileges of all lobbyists of said principal to lobby on behalf of such principal would be suspended as of August 19, 1980; and

Whereas, as of August 18, 1980 each of the following principals has still failed to file such an expense statement with the Secretary of State; now, therefore,

I, Vel Phillips, as Secretary of State of Wisconsin under the authority granted to me by s.13.63(2), Wis. Stats. do hereby suspend the privilege of each of the following lobbyists to lobby on behalf of the principals whose name is listed opposite the name of such lobbyist:

Lawrence E. Allwardt, Wis. Federation of Teachers  
Roy E. Kubista, Milwaukee Dist. Council 48, AFSCME  
John A. Lawton, Milwaukee Dist. Council 48, AFSCME  
Donovan W. Riley, The Medical College of Wis., Inc.

Each of the above suspensions takes effect at 12:00 A.M. on August 19, 1980 and remains in effect until such time as the indicated principal of each such lobbyist files with the Secretary of State a complete expense statement required under s.13.68, Wis. Stats.

Any principal or lobbyist who may be aggrieved by one of the above suspensions may request a hearing under s.227.064, Wis. Stats.
