I am pleased to inform you that, under section 15.197 (12) (c), Wis. Stats., I am appointing R. Michael Ferrall, 1983 East Bluemound Road, Mt. Horeb, WI 53572, to serve as a public member on the Radiation Protection Council, effective January 5, 1981, immediately after his retirement from the Legislature.

The Radiation Protection Council was created by Chapter 320, Laws of 1979. It consists of nine public members and one member from each house of the Legislature. The council will monitor the
