EXECUTIVE COMMUNICATIONS

A Proclamation

- I, Lee Sherman Dreyfus, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Section 11 of Article IV and Section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do hereby require the convening of a special session of the Legislature to take place at the Capitol in Madison on the 6th day of April, A.D., 1982, at 10:00 a.m., solely for the purpose of considering and acting upon the following specific pieces of legislative business, to-wit:
 - State finances and appropriations, adjusting the state's biennial budget, providing for a study, granting rule-making authority, providing penalties, decreasing and making appropriations.
 - Amending the Constitution to earmark one percent of the aggregate sales prices on items subject to any state sales or use taxes for education property tax relief in addition to 1983-84 school property tax credits.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this 5th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred eighty-two.
