Attached is the sixth annual Report to the Governor on the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) and Related Activities for 1981-82. This Report has been prepared by the Governor's Employment and Training Office (GETO) as one of its responsibilities under the CETA legislation. It is designed to summarize both statewide and local CETA activities in Wisconsin, as well as other related employment, training and educational programs that prepare and place Wisconsin citizens in jobs.

This Report is a resource document for persons interested in the organization, scope, and service levels of CETA programs for Fiscal Year 1981, planned levels of service for Fiscal 1982, and the scope of other non-CETA employment and training programs. Special attention has been given to projects of statewide significance funded by the State Employment and Training Council and administered by the Governor's Employment and Training Office.
