EXECUTIVE COMMUNICATIONS

A Proclamation

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, Section Eleven and Article V, Section Four of the Wisconsin Constitution, do hereby require the convening of a special session of the Legislature to take place at the Capitol in the City of Madison on the eleventh day of July, A.D., 1983, at 1:30 p.m., solely for the purpose of considering and acting upon the following legislative business:

- (1) enacting a plan of senate and assembly districts and other revisions relating to legislative districts and re-districting.

- (2) creating a Tax Incremental Finance Joint Review Board with the purpose of reviewing creation of Tax Incremental Finance districts.
