#### Executive Order Number 45

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Section 11 of Article IV and Section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do hereby require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on February 2, 1984 at 9:30 a.m. solely to consider and act upon the following specific legislative business:

- 1. Altering the schedules for payment of Wisconsin state property tax relief and handicapped education, transportation, and general equalization aids to school districts.
- 2. Reducing the corporate and individual surtaxes for taxable year 1984 from 10% to 2.5%.
