1985 Wisconsin Act 193

AN ACT to authorize and direct expenditure of \$52,192.85 from moneys appropriated to the board of regents of the university of Wisconsin system for payment of a claim against the state made by Wallace O'Neill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is authorized and directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.285 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1985, \$52,192.85 in payment of a claim against the state by Wallace O'Neill, Eau Claire, Wisconsin, to compensate him for attorney fees, costs and disbursements incurred in the

defense of 3 felony counts brought against him for alleged misconduct committed on October 5, 1981, in the course of his affairs as supervisor of police officers at the university of Wisconsin-Eau Claire. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state and its officers, employes and agents for any costs or damages incurred by the claimant in connection with this incident.
