EXECUTIVE COMMUNICATIONS

Executive Order Number 91

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Section 11 of Article IV and Section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on January 27, 1986 at 11:00 a.m. solely to consider and act upon the following specific legislative business:

1. Reducing certain appropriations, making changes in certain program revenue appropriations and increasing and making changes in certain segregated appropriations.
2. Making changes in the Homestead Tax Relief program.
