## 1987 Wisconsin Act 162

AN ACT to amend 59.07 (3) (a) of the statutes, relating to delegation of county board powers relating to accounts and claims.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 59.07 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.07 (3) (a) Examine and settle all accounts of the county and all claims, demands or causes of action against the county and issue county orders therefor. In counties having a population of less than 50,000, the board may delegate its power in regard to current accounts, claims, demands or causes of action against the county to a standing committee where the amount does not exceed ~~\$2,500 and in all~~ \$5,000. In counties

having a population of 50,000 or more, the board may delegate its power in regard to current accounts, claims, demands or causes of action against the county to a standing committee ~~where~~ if the amount does not exceed \$5,000 \$10,000. Instead of delegating its power under this paragraph to a standing committee, the board may, by resolution adopted by majority vote, delegate such power to the chairperson of a standing committee. Such a resolution remains in effect for one year after its effective date or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
