1987 Wisconsin Act 2

AN ACT relating to making an appropriation to reimburse attorneys and investigators for providing services under the state public defender program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions. The requirements of 1985 Wisconsin Act 120, section 3056 (2r), and section 20.003 (4) of the statutes do not apply to this act.

SECTION 2. Appropriation changes. The appropriation to the public defender board under section

20.550 (1) (d) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1987, is increased by \$5,440,000 for fiscal year 1986-87 to provide reimbursement of private attorneys acting as counsel for indigents and reimbursement for private investigator services.
