1989 WISCONSIN ACT 42

AN ACT to affect laws of 1929, chapter 150, section 2m, relating to: uses of certain lands adjacent to the shore of Lake Michigan.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Laws of 1929, chapter 150, section 2m is created to read:

[Laws of 1929, chapter 150] Section 2m. Any person who owns the lands described in SECTION 2 of this act shall provide a reasonably direct route to the shore of Lake Michigan to allow handicapped and elderly people

to fish, engage in recreational activities and exercise all other public rights to use and enjoy the lands described in SECTION 2 of this act. If the owner of the lands described in SECTION 2 of this act rents the land to a tenant under a lease or to a periodic tenant or permits a tenant at will to occupy the land, the owner shall enter into an agreement requiring the tenant to comply with this SECTION. If the tenant fails to comply with the agreement, the owner is responsible for compliance with this SECTION.
