1989 WISCONSIN ACT 57

AN ACT to direct expenditure of \$119,095.50 from the general fund for payment of a claim against the state made by Clipper Exxpress Company.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.505 (4) (d) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1987 and 1989, \$119,095.50 in payment of a claim

against the state made by Clipper Exxpress Company, Chicago, Illinois, to compensate it in part for overpayment of income and franchise taxes for the years 1977 to 1982 as the result of an incorrect assessment by the department of revenue. Acceptance of this payment releases this state and its officers, employes and agents from any further liability resulting from this assessment.
