1995 WISCONSIN ACT 324

AN ACT to create 111.81 (7) (d) and 111.825 (2) (e) of the statutes; relating to: employment relations for attorneys employed in the office of the state public defender.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 111.81 (7) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

111.81 (7) (d) Attorneys employed in the office of the state public defender, except supervisors, management employes or individuals who are privy to confidential matters affecting the employer–employe relationship.

SECTION 2. 111.825 (2) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

111.825 (2) (e) Attorneys employed in the office of the state public defender.

SECTION 3. Effective date.

(1) This act takes effect on July 1, 1997.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES 1993–94: Effective date of acts. “Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor’s partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated” by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
