1995 WISCONSIN ACT 340

AN ACT to amend 939.64 (2) of the statutes; relating to: wearing a bulletproof vest while committing a felony and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 939.64 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

939.64 (2) If a person commits a felony while wearing a bulletproof garment, the maximum term of impris-

onment prescribed by law for that crime may be increased by 5 10 years.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to offenses committed on the effective date of this subsection.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES 1993-94: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated" by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
