



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 1076**

May 13, 1996 - Offered by Representatives ROBSON, BOCK and MORRIS-TATUM.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 12: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 2m.** 48.983 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 48.983 (5) A county, town, village or city may ~~adopt~~ enact an ordinance  
5 regulating the ~~conduct regulated by this section only if it strictly conforms to~~  
6 purchase or possession of cigarettes or tobacco products by a child, if the ordinance  
7 is at least as strict as this section. A county ordinance ~~adopted~~ enacted under this  
8 section does not apply within any town, village or city that has ~~adopted or adopts~~  
9 enacted or enacts an ordinance under this subsection.”.

10 **2.** Page 6, line 20: delete “in a school or”.

11 **3.** Page 7, line 17: after that line insert:

12 “**SECTION 28m.** 134.66 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

13 134.66 (5) LOCAL ORDINANCE. A county, town, village or city may ~~adopt~~ enact  
14 an ordinance regulating the ~~conduct regulated by this section only if it strictly~~

1 ~~conforms to this section~~ sale or giving away of cigarettes and tobacco products if the  
2 ordinance is at least as strict as this section. A county ordinance ~~adopted~~ enacted  
3 under this subsection does not apply within any town, village or city that has ~~adopted~~  
4 ~~or adopts~~ enacted or enacts an ordinance under this subsection.”.
