



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 1076**

May 13, 1996 – Offered by Representatives R. YOUNG, WILDER, BOCK, BALDWIN and ROBSON.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 17: after that line insert:

3 “SECTION 8m. 134.65 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 134.65 (1) No person shall in any manner, or upon any pretense, or by any  
5 device, directly or indirectly sell, expose for sale, possess with intent to sell,  
6 exchange, or barter, ~~dispose of or give away~~ any cigarettes or tobacco products to any  
7 person not holding a license as herein provided or a permit under ss. 139.30 to 139.41  
8 or 139.79 without first obtaining a license from the clerk of the city, village or town  
9 wherein such privilege is sought to be exercised.”.

10 **2.** Page 6, line 22: delete lines 22 to 24 and substitute:

11 “SECTION 24m. 134.66 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

12 134.66 (2) (d) No retailer, manufacturer,”.

13 **3.** Page 7, line 4: delete lines 4 to 7.

14 **4.** Page 7, line 20: delete “and (cm) 1.” and substitute “, (cm) 1. and (d)”.
