



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 1076**

May 13, 1996 – Offered by Representatives R. YOUNG, WILDER, BOCK, CULLEN,
BALDWIN and ROBSON.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 7, line 7: after that line insert:

3 “SECTION 25g. 134.66 (2) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

4 134.66 (2) (f) 1. No retailer may offer for sale cigarettes or tobacco products in
5 a manner that results in their being directly accessible to the public.

6 2. No retailer or retailer’s employe or agent may sell, exchange or barter
7 cigarettes or tobacco products to another person unless the retailer or his or her
8 employe or agent assists that person in obtaining the cigarettes or tobacco products.

9 3. Subdivisions 1. and 2. do not apply to the sale of cigarettes or tobacco
10 products from tobacco vending machines.”

11 **2.** Page 7, line 17: after that line insert:

12 “SECTION 28g. 134.66 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
