



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 220**

October 5, 1995 - Offered by Representative LINTON.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 45.25 (1), 45.25 (3) (a) and 45.25 (4) (a); and **to repeal and**
2 **recreate** 45.25 (3) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** the veterans' tuition and fee
3 reimbursement program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 45.25 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 45.25 (1) ADMINISTRATION. The department of veterans affairs shall administer
6 a tuition and fee reimbursement program for eligible veterans enrolling as
7 undergraduates in any institution ~~or center within the university of Wisconsin~~
8 ~~system or enrolling in any technical college under ch. 38~~ of higher education.

9 **SECTION 2.** 45.25 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 45.25 (3) (a) An individual who meets the requirements under sub. (2), upon
11 satisfactory completion of an undergraduate semester in any institution ~~or center~~
12 ~~within the university of Wisconsin system or a semester at any technical college~~
13 ~~district school under ch. 38~~ of higher education, may be reimbursed for up to 25% of
14 the individual's average tuition and fees, ~~other than textbooks and other costs,~~

1 ~~charged by the institution, center or school~~ charged a resident undergraduate at each
2 technical college and at each institution and center within the University of
3 Wisconsin System or the difference between the individual's tuition and fees and the
4 grants or scholarships, including those made under s. 21.49, that the individual
5 receives specifically for the payment of the tuition or fees, whichever is less.
6 Reimbursement is available only for tuition and fees that are part of a curriculum
7 that is relevant to a degree in a particular course of study at the institution, ~~center~~
8 ~~or school~~ of higher education. Reimbursement under this paragraph may not exceed
9 the costs of the individual's tuition and fees.

10 **SECTION 3.** 45.25 (3) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Acts 27
11 and (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:

12 45.25 (3) (a) An individual who meets the requirements under sub. (2), upon
13 satisfactory completion of an undergraduate semester in any institution of higher
14 education, may be reimbursed for up to 35% of the average tuition and fees charged
15 a resident undergraduate at each technical college and at each institution and center
16 within the University of Wisconsin System or the difference between the individual's
17 tuition and fees and the grants or scholarships, including those made under s. 21.49,
18 that the individual receives specifically for the payment of the tuition or fees,
19 whichever is less. Reimbursement is available only for tuition and fees that are part
20 of a curriculum that is relevant to a degree in a particular course of study at the
21 institution of higher education. Reimbursement under this paragraph may not
22 exceed the costs of the individual's tuition and fees.

23 **SECTION 4.** 45.25 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

24 45.25 (4) (a) An individual is not eligible for reimbursement under sub. (2) for
25 more than 120 credits of part-time study or 8 full semesters of full-time study at any

1 ~~4-year institution or center within the university of Wisconsin system of higher~~
2 ~~education~~ or 60 credits of part-time study or 4 full semesters of full-time study at
3 ~~a technical college under ch. 38~~ any 2-year institution of higher education.

4 **SECTION 5. Initial applicability.**

5 (1) The treatment of section 45.25 (1) and (4) (a) of the statutes and the
6 amendment of section 45.25 (3) (a) of the statutes first apply to applications for
7 reimbursement of tuition and fees received by the department of veterans affairs on
8 the effective date of this subsection.

9 **SECTION 6. Effective date.**

10 (1) The repeal and recreation of section 45.25 (3) (a) of the statutes takes effect
11 on July 1, 1996, or on the day after publication, whichever is later.
