



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 554**

September 20, 1995 – Offered by Representatives BOCK, WOOD, MURAT, NOTESTEIN
and HOVEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 17, line 12: after that line insert:

3 “(7) STATE CONCENTRATION LIMIT. The commissioner may not approve any
4 transaction under sub. (3) (a) if, upon consummation of the transaction, the applicant
5 would control a greater percentage of the total amount of deposits of insured
6 depository institutions in the state than the percentage specified under 12 USC 1842
7 (d) (2) (B) (ii).”.

8 **2.** Page 20, line 20: after that line insert:

9 “SECTION 29s. 221.59 (7) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act
10 (this act), is amended to read:

11 221.59 (7) STATE CONCENTRATION LIMIT. The commissioner division may not
12 approve any transaction under sub. (3) (a) if, upon consummation of the transaction,
13 the applicant would control a greater percentage of the total amount of deposits of
14 insured depository institutions in the state than the percentage specified under 12
15 USC 1842 (d) (2) (B) (ii).”.
