



**SENATE AMENDMENT 7,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 591**

March 13, 1996 – Offered by Senators GROBSCHMIDT, SHIBILSKI, C. POTTER, JAUCH, MOORE, RISSER, MOEN, CHVALA, GEORGE, ANDREA, BRESKE, DECKER and WINEKE.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute  
2           amendment 3, as follows:

3           **1.** Page 64, line 11: after that line insert:

4           “11. Approve customized labor training programs under s. 49.147 (4) (ap).”.

5           **2.** Page 75, line 1: delete that line, as affected by chief clerk’s correction, and  
6           substitute:

7           “(ap) *Customized labor training.* 1. A participant under this subsection may  
8           participate in a customized labor training program under this paragraph in order to  
9           satisfy all or part of a participation requirement under this subsection.

10           2. A customized labor training program may be offered to a participant under  
11           this paragraph if the program meets all of the following requirements:

12           a. The program provides training for a specifically identified job.

13           b. An employer has offered to place a program participant in the specifically  
14           identified job upon successful completion of the program.

15           c. The program has been approved by the community steering committee.
