



**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 73**

June 6, 1995 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON HUMAN RESOURCES, LABOR, TOURISM,
VETERANS AND MILITARY AFFAIRS.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 21.49 (3) (b) 1. of the statutes; **relating to:** national guard
2 tuition grants and making an appropriation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do
enact as follows:*

3 **SECTION 1.** 21.49 (3) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

4 21.49 (3) (b) 1. Be submitted to the department for approval of payment no later
5 than ~~6 months~~ 90 days after the completion date of the course;

6 **SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.**

7 (1) (a) Notwithstanding section 21.49 (2) of the statutes and section 21.49 (3)
8 (b) 1. of the statutes, as affected by this act, tuition grants provided from the
9 appropriation under section 20.465 (2) (a) of the statutes for fiscal year 1994-95 shall
10 be limited to national guard members who are in pay grades of E-6 or below, W-2
11 or below and O-3 or below. To receive a grant under this subsection, a national guard
12 member in pay grades of E-6 or below shall apply no later than 60 days after the
13 effective date of this paragraph and a national guard member in pay grades of W-2
14 or below or O-3 or below shall apply no later than 80 days after the effective date of

1 this paragraph. Notwithstanding section 21.49 (3) (d) of the statutes, if moneys are
2 insufficient to provide grants to national guard members who are in pay grades of
3 E-6 or below equal to the 50% level under section 21.49 (3) (a) of the statutes, the
4 amounts shall be prorated among all of those in pay grades E-6 or below who apply.

5 (b) Notwithstanding section 21.49 (2) of the statutes, and section 21.49 (3) (b)
6 1. of the statutes, as affected by this act, any moneys remaining in the appropriation
7 under section 20.465 (2) (a) of the statutes for fiscal year 1994-95 after payments are
8 made to national guard members in pay grades of E-6 or below shall be used to pay
9 grants to national guard members who are in pay grades of W-2 or below and O-3
10 or below. Notwithstanding section 21.49 (3) (d) of the statutes, if moneys are
11 insufficient to provide grants to national guard members who are in pay grades of
12 W-2 or below and O-3 or below equal to the 50% level under section 21.49 (3) of the
13 statutes, the amounts shall be prorated among all of those in pay grades W-2 or
14 below and O-3 or below who apply.

15 (2) Notwithstanding section 20.001 (3) (a) of the statutes, the department of
16 military affairs shall make the payment for any course completed before July 1, 1995,
17 from the appropriation under section 20.465 (2) of the statutes for the 1994-95 fiscal
18 year.

19 **SECTION 3. Appropriation changes.**

20 (1) NATIONAL GUARD TUITION GRANTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3)
21 of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of military affairs under
22 section 20.465 (2) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1993 and 1995, the
23 dollar amount is increased by \$590,300 for fiscal year 1994-95 to provide additional
24 tuition grants to national guard members.
