



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 119**

March 13, 1996 – Offered by Representatives GREEN and BOCK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
2 amendment 1, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 2, line 11: delete that line and substitute: “tages and disadvantages
4 of accepting treatment, and the alternatives ~~to accepting~~”.

5 **2.** Page 2, line 15: after “al” insert: “to his or her chronic mental illness”.

6 **3.** Page 3, line 2: delete that line and substitute: “tages and disadvantages of
7 accepting medication or treatment, and the alternatives”.

8 **4.** Page 3, line 6: after “al” insert: “to his or her mental illness, developmental
9 disability, alcoholism or drug dependence”.

10 **5.** Page 4, line 19: delete that line and substitute: “vantages and
11 disadvantages of accepting treatment and the alternatives.”.

12 **6.** Page 4, line 21: after “alternatives” insert: “to his or her chronic mental
13 illness”.

14 **7.** Page 5, line 7: delete that line and substitute: “tages and disadvantages of
15 accepting treatment, and the alternatives ~~to accepting~~”.
