



1995 SENATE BILL 334

September 19, 1995 - Introduced by Senators ROSENZWEIG, BUETTNER, DARLING, PANZER and FARROW, cosponsored by Representatives GARD and WALKER. Referred to Committee on Health, Human Services and Aging.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 59.07 (154) of the statutes; **relating to:** a county-funded relief
2 program operated for a specific class or classes of persons.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, beginning January 1, 1996, a county may operate a county-funded relief program for all dependent persons in that county to provide dependent persons with such services, commodities or money as relief, as the county determines to be reasonable and necessary under the circumstances.

This bill allows a county to operate the relief program for a specific class or classes of persons, rather than for all dependent persons.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 59.07 (154) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, is
4 amended to read:

5 59.07 (154) OPERATION OF RELIEF PROGRAMS. Operate a program of relief to
6 dependent persons residing in a for a specific class or classes of persons residing in
7 that county. The program may provide dependent persons with such services,
8 commodities or money county may set such eligibility criteria to obtain relief, and
9 may provide such services, commodities or money as relief, as the county determines

SECTION 1

1 to be reasonable and necessary under the circumstances. The program may include
2 work components. The county may enact any ordinances necessary or useful to the
3 operation of a relief program under this subsection. Counties may use vehicle
4 registration information from the department of transportation in determining
5 eligibility for relief programs under this subsection.

6 **SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act takes effect on January 1, 1996, or the
7 day after publication, whichever is later.
