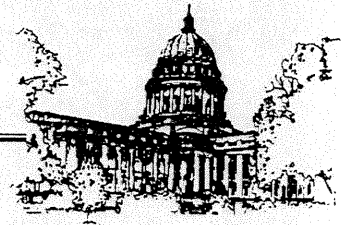


Dear Chairman Ott and Committee Members;

Thank you for allowing Senate Bill (SB) 210 to have a hearing on short notice.

SB 210, authored by Senator Brian Rude, is the companion bill to Assembly Bill 376. SB 210 was amended in the senate and now contains only the removal of the 1/8 mile requirement for the construction of a rendering facility. The senate Transportation and Local Affairs Committee passed the measure unanimously, as did the senate body.

Removal of the 1/8 mile requirement will not allow rendering facilities to operate anywhere they chose, local ordinances will be in place to deal with possible development. In the case of Karem Inc., a plant has been constructed in the Virocqua area and awaits licensure, but the extremes of the statute is prohibiting the plant to open.

I can not express upon you enough the need for this type of facility to assist farmers in the removal of dead livestock, especially in the extreme heat we are now experiencing. I would encourage the passage of SB 210, and thank you for allowing me to testify.
