**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 14,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 100**

September 16, 1997 - Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1351, line 17: after that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 3009t.** 146.83 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 146.83 (2) The health care provider shall provide each patient with a statement
5 paraphrasing the provisions of this section and specifying the procedures by which
6 the health care provider protects the confidentiality of patient health care records
7 either upon admission to an inpatient health care facility, as defined in s. 50.135 (1),
8 or upon the first provision of services by the health care provider.

9 **SECTION 3009u.** 146.832 of the statutes is created to read:

10 **146.832 Use of social security number to identify a patient.** No one may
11 use the social security number of a patient to identify that patient or his or her

1 patient health care records, except as required under health care programs or
2 services that are funded by state or federal funds.

3 **SECTION 3009v.** 146.84 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 146.84 (2) (am)
4 (intro.).

5 **SECTION 3009w.** 146.84 (2) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 146.84 (2) (am) 1.

6 **SECTION 3009wm.** 146.84 (2) (am) 3. of the statutes is created to read:

7 146.84 (2) (am) 3. Violates s. 146.832.

8 **SECTION 3009x.** 146.84 (2) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 146.84 (2) (bm) and
9 amended to read:

10 146.84 (2) (bm) ~~Discloses~~ Whoever discloses confidential information with
11 knowledge that the disclosure is unlawful and is not reasonably necessary to protect
12 another from harm may be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned for not more
13 than 5 years or both.

14 **SECTION 3009y.** 146.84 (2) (c) of the statutes is renumbered 146.84 (2) (am) 2.”.
