



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 6,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 463**

November 13, 1997 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 8, line 21: after "degree." insert "To effectuate this purpose and the

3 purpose specified in par. (am), it is the intent of the legislature that the provisions

4 of this chapter that protect unborn children against those harmful effects and that

5 provide for the needs of unborn children, as described in par. (am), shall be construed

6 to apply throughout an expectant mother's pregnancy to the extent that application

7 of those provisions throughout an expectant mother's pregnancy is constitutionally

8 permissible and that expectant mothers who habitually lack self-control in the use

9 of alcohol beverages, controlled substances or controlled substance analogs,

10 exhibited to a severe degree, be encouraged to seek treatment for that habitual lack

11 of self-control voluntarily when voluntary treatment would be practicable and

12 effective."
