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**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 31,  
TO 1997 SENATE BILL 315**

March 10, 1998 - Offered by Representatives FREESE, ALBERS, PORTER and  
WASSERMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute  
2 amendment 2, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 2, line 7: delete “an appropriation” and substitute “appropriations”.

4 **2.** Page 3, line 18: after that line insert:

5 “SECTION 5w. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place,  
6 insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

8 **20.435 Health and family services, department**

9 **of**

10 (1) HEALTH SERVICES PLANNING, REGULATION AND

11 DELIVERY; STATE OPERATIONS

12 (dg) Health care information; pilot

13 project GPR A -0- 250,000

1           **SECTION 5x.** 20.435 (1) (dg) of the statutes is created to read:

2           20.435 (1) (dg) *Health care information; pilot project.* The amounts in the  
3 schedule for collection of outpatient data under the pilot project under 1997  
4 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), section 65 (3).

5           **SECTION 5y.** 20.435 (1) (dg) of the statutes, as created by 1997 Wisconsin Act  
6 .... (this act), is repealed.”.

7           **3.** Page 3, line 25: after that line insert:

8           “**SECTION 6c.** 20.435 (1) (hg) of the statutes, as affected by 1997 Wisconsin Acts  
9 27 and .... (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:

10           20.435 (1) (hg) *General program operations; health care information.* The  
11 amounts in the schedule to fund the activities of the department of health and family  
12 services and the board on health care information under ch. 153. The contract fees  
13 paid under s. 153.05 (6m), assessments paid under s. 153.60 (2m) and fees paid under  
14 s. 153.60 (3m) shall be credited to this appropriation account.”.

15           **4.** Page 9, line 8: after that line, delete the material inserted by senate  
16 amendment 1 to senate substitute amendment 2.

17           **5.** Page 13, line 20: delete “and” and substitute “and<sub>1</sub>”.

18           **6.** Page 13, line 22: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
19 with page 14, line 2, as affected by senate amendment 1 to senate substitute  
20 amendment 2, and substitute “(1) (hi) from the prior fiscal year and the amount in  
21 the appropriation account under s. 20.435 (1) (dg) for the fiscal year, to hospitals in  
22 proportion to each hospital’s respective gross private pay patient revenues during  
23 the hospital’s most recently concluded entire fiscal year and to ambulatory surgery  
24 centers. Each”.

1           **7.** Page 14, line 3: delete “hospital health care provider” and substitute  
2           “hospital and ambulatory surgery center”.

3           **8.** Page 14, line 5: after that line insert:

4           “**SECTION 49c.** 153.60 of the statutes, as affected by 1997 Wisconsin Act .... (this  
5           act), is repealed and recreated to read:

6           **153.60 Funding operations of department and board.** (1) The  
7           department shall, by the first October 1 after the commencement of each fiscal year,  
8           estimate the total amount of expenditures under this chapter for the department and  
9           the board for that fiscal year for data collection, data base development and  
10          maintenance, generation of data files and standard reports, orientation and training  
11          provided under s. 153.05 (9) and maintaining the board.

12          **(2m)** The department shall assess the estimated total amount for that fiscal  
13          year, as established in sub. (1), that relates directly to hospitals and ambulatory  
14          surgery centers to hospitals in proportion to each hospital’s respective gross  
15          private-pay patient revenues during the hospital’s most recently concluded entire  
16          fiscal year and to ambulatory surgery centers. Each hospital and ambulatory  
17          surgery center shall pay the assessment on or before December 1. All payments of  
18          assessments shall be deposited in the appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (hg).

19          **(3m)** The department shall establish fees for the provision of reports under ss.  
20          153.10, 153.15, 153.20, 153.25, 153.30 and 153.35 and the consumer guide under s.  
21          153.21. The amounts of the fees in each fiscal year shall equal the estimated total  
22          amount of expenditures under this chapter, as established under sub. (1), less the  
23          amounts assessed under sub. (2) and less the estimated total amount to be received  
24          for purposes of administration of this chapter under s. 20.435 (1) (hi) during the fiscal

1 year and the unencumbered balance, if any, of the amount received for purposes of  
2 administration of this chapter under s. 20.435 (1) (hi) from the prior fiscal year. The  
3 department shall deposit the fees paid under this subsection into the appropriation  
4 account under s. 20.435 (1) (hg).”.

5 **9.** Page 15, line 10: delete “, (k)”.

6 **10.** Page 15, line 13: delete lines 13 and 14.

7 **11.** Page 17, line 4: after that line, delete the material inserted by senate  
8 amendment 1 to senate substitute amendment 2.

9 **12.** Page 29, line 5: after that line, after the material inserted by assembly  
10 amendment 5, and before the material inserted by assembly amendment 25, insert:

11 “(3p) PILOT PROJECT FOR OUTPATIENT DATA COLLECTION. From the appropriation  
12 account under section 20.435 (1) (dg) of the statutes, as created by this act, the  
13 department of health and family services shall, as a pilot project, provide payment  
14 to collect outpatient health care data from health care providers, as defined in section  
15 153.01 (4t) of the statutes, as created by this act. No encumbrances or expenditures  
16 may be made under this subsection after June 30, 1999.”.

17 **13.** Page 29, line 20: after that line insert:

18 “(1m) The repeal of section 20.435 (1) (dg) of the statutes and the repeal and  
19 recreation of sections 20.435 (1) (hg) and 153.60 of the statutes take effect on July  
20 1, 1999.”.
